Bidders shall submit their bids on the county form supplied by Bingham County.



Introduction:	Bingham County is requesting and accepting bid proposals for an approximate quantity of 500,000 square yards (SY) of Micro-surfacing Type 3 Mix Material for application on specific rural and subdivision paved county roadways within Bingham County.
Bidding Type:	Formal Sealed Bid. Bidder will be required to complete and submit all required bid documentation provided by Bingham County. Sealed Bids MUST be received by the County Commissioner’s Assistant in the Bingham County Clerk’s Office by the bid closing date and time. Bidder must provide proof of all appropriate licenses and certificate, including Workman’s Compensation/Liability Insurance.

<p>Questions and Interpretations:</p>	<p>No oral interpretations of the Bid will be made to any Bidder. <u>All questions must be submitted in writing, by email to dwhited@binghamid.gov. All answers and clarifications will be sent to all bid plan holders via addendum. All questions and inquiries must be received no later than five (5) days prior to bid opening date.</u></p>
<p>Description of Work and Project Specifics Required by Contractor:</p>	<p>Bingham County is requesting for bid proposals for an approximate quantity of 500,000 square yards (SY) of Micro-surfacing Type 3 Mix Material for application on specific paved county roadways within Bingham County.</p> <p>Submitted bid proposals shall include all of the following;</p> <p>Type 3 micro-surfacing mix, to include mix design, emulsion (liquid additives & mineral filler), and calibrations, as per ISSA specifications.</p> <p>Application of micro-surfacing mix material must be applied at a ratio of between twenty-eight (28) to thirty-two (32) pounds per square yard.</p> <p>A twelve foot by two hundred foot (12' X 200') Test Strip.</p> <p>All equipment required to load, mix, and place micro-surfacing material. A minimum of no less than three (3) micro-surfacing paving trucks shall be required in operation for the complete duration of micro-surfacing application.</p> <p>A minimum of 30,000 square yards of micro-surfacing material shall be laid by the end of each day of work, excluding weather delays.</p> <p>Providing proper ISSA covering of all utility and service on roadway accesses, to include but not be limited to; manholes, water valves, inlet grates, etc.</p> <p>Work must begin no later than Monday, June 16th, 2025 and upon commencement of work shall be performed continuously, excluding weather delays, until completed.</p> <p>All work must be performed between the hours of: 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. MST, Monday through Friday.</p> <p>Provide any and all traffic control and/or road closures in accordance with the MUTCD, which shall include but not limited to, plans, signage, flagging, devices, and man power for work areas affected by the micro-surfacing road work.</p>
<p>Description of Work and Project Specifics Provided by Bingham County:</p>	<p>Supply all aggregate and water needed for the county roads micro-surfacing material project.</p> <p>Provide pre-cleaning and sweeping of specific paved county roads prior to being micro-surfaced.</p>

<p>Description of Work and Project Specifics Provided by Bingham County:</p>	<p>Provide pavement repair, crack weeding, sealing, tree trimming, rolling, post sweeping, removal, replacement, protection, or referencing of permanent or temporary stripe/markers.</p> <p>Placement of referencing with tabs for striping prior to micro-surfacing.</p> <p>Provide notification to the Public to the areas of the Micro-Surfacing being applied on specific county roadways.</p>
<p>Special Considerations:</p>	<p>Mobilization, set up, and all other costs must be included in the total bid amount submitted.</p> <p>Pre-Construction Meeting between Bingham County Public Works and Awarded Contractor shall be performed a minimum of ten (10) days prior to the commencement of work.</p> <p>Awarded Contractor will be required and responsible for the completion of daily log sheets and daily yield check sheets. Daily logs and daily yield sheets shall be provided by Bingham County. Awarded Contractor shall be responsible for turning in the daily logs and daily yield sheets to the Bingham County Public Works Department's designated representative prior to the beginning of the start of the next day's work.</p> <p>Bingham County will haul and place all needed aggregate and water to the specific staging area(s) within ten (10) miles or that which is agreed upon by Bingham County and the successful bidder.</p> <p>Bingham County and the Awarded Contractor shall negotiate field verification of all applicable areas to receive application of micro-surfacing mix material pertaining to square yardage prior to the initiation of project work.</p> <p>Bingham County shall reserve the right to apply financial penalties against the Awarded Contractor in the event of a failed ISSA specification standards test of their Emulsion being applied on Bingham County paved roadways.</p>
<p>Bid awarded based on:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Warrant Statement and duration of coverage for defects in material and workmanship. • Details of the bids with respect to clear and understandable descriptions the proposed furnished work and time line for completion of the project. • Total Price, including all aspects of the work expected. • Assurances that the completion of work will be completed in the time agreed upon.
