BINGHAM COUNTY RESOLUTION 2024-12

RESOLUTION AND ORDER DECREASING THE SPEED LIMIT FOR COUNTY LINE ROAD FROM 800 EAST TO 900 EAST, BLACKFOOT, IDAHO.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Idaho Code §49-105(D)(11), 49-207(2), 49-654 (1)&(2), which allows local authorities, in their respective jurisdictions, to determine and declare a responsible and safe maximum speed limit; and

WHEREAS, the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices states the main criteria for determining the proper speed limits on public roads is the 85th percentile speed; and

WHEREAS, the 85th percentile for the specified section of County Line Road is the same as Bonneville County's speed limit of 50 mph. The land width, the sight distance of the approaches, the ADT, the new subdivisions, other driveways, were all factored in the traffic investigation in maintaining a safe road area for the public while keeping free flow of traffic; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Bingham County Commissioners find it in the best interest of the citizens of Bingham County to decrease the speed limit on County Line Road from 800 East to 900 East, from 55mph (currently unposted) to 50 mph, to match Bonneville County.
