## ABERDEEN SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 58 SUPPLEMENTAL LEVY ABERDEEN SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 58

The Board of Trustees of Aberdeen School District No. 58, Bingham County, Idaho, is seeking authorization to levy a Supplemental Levy for the following purposes and approximate amount of levy funds to be allocated to each use: (i) Salaries and benefits for non-certificated staff, \$500,000; (ii) School resource officer, safety and security, \$65,000; (iii) Classroom supplies and curriculum, \$230,000; (iv) Building supplies, \$45,000; (v) Technology devices and software, \$65,000; (vi) Maintenance, grounds, and custodial supplies, \$45,000; for a total amount of \$950,000.

"Shall the Board of Trustees of Aberdeen School District No. 58, Bingham County, State of Idaho, be authorized to levy a supplemental levy, as permitted by law in Section 33-802(3), Idaho Code, in the amount of Nine Hundred Fifty Thousand and no/100 dollars (\$950,000) per year for a period of two (2) years, commencing with the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2024 and ending June 30, 2026, for the purpose of paying all lawful expenses of maintaining and operating the schools of the district provided in the resolution of the Board of Trustees adopted on March 20th, 2024?"

The estimated average annual cost to the taxpayer on the proposed levy is a tax of \$298.65 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value, per year, based on current conditions.
